About the University

Shri Vishwakarma Skill University (SVSU) is India's first Government Skill University established by the Government of Haryana to promote skill based education, entrepreneurship and research across all the sectors of country through its unique Industry Integrated Dual Education Model. The courses are outcome based, job role oriented, NSQF aligned and UGC compliance having requisite skill and general education component. The University has also taken a lead in designing and implementing innovative NSQF aligned diploma, advanced diploma and degree courses as per UGC & NSDA guidelines.

Introduction

Most of the countries in the world are reforming their qualifications and developing frameworks to relate these qualifications with each other as per their relevance to society and market. Government of India also notified a National Skill Qualification Framework with one of the objective to develop a set of qualification for each level based on outcome which are accepted across the nation. These qualifications are registered in national qualification register after the approval of National Skill Qualifications Committee (NSQC). The National Qualifications Register is the official national public record of all qualifications aligned to NSQF levels, qualification pathways and accrediting authorities. It gives learners and other users of qualifications access to all the qualifications registered and currently on offer. The Register is designed to be of use to learners, employers, awarding bodies, training providers, schools, colleges, government agencies and their partners.

It will facilitate access to and retrieval of information on all qualifications in the NSQF through a full search facility. The process for including a qualification in the NSQF involve the qualification development body submitting a completed Qualification File to NSDA for evaluation and approval by the NSQC. A Qualification File is a template designed to capture necessary information of a Qualification from the perspective of NSQF compliance. The Qualification File is normally submitted by the awarding body for the approval of the qualification.

Objectives

- To Develop concept of outcome based learning as per National Skill Qualification Framework.
- To understand various components of Qualification File and hands on training will be given to prepare a Qualification File.
- To design a course which is NSQF aligned and UGC compliant in dual education mode.
- To be familiar with - NSQF, Outcome based Qualifications, Qualification Files and process of approval of QF.
- To develop at least one qualification file ready to be submitted to NSDA.

Methodology

First day of workshop will facilitate the participants to discuss to discuss the issues relating QF Mapping and NSQF alignment. Two days of the workshop will provide an opportunity and skill to the participants to develop Qualification file of their course. Therefore, the Participants are requested to bring the following documents of a course for development of QF and NSQF - mapping & alignment during the workshop.

- Scheme and syllabus of the course.
- Lesson plans of all the subjects of the course.
- Outcome of all the Job Roles (Progressive Pathways with multiple entry exit options)
- Evidence of Need for the qualification in the form of reports, surveys, Industry validation letters etc..
- OJT plan or the name of QP identified for the course.
- Assessment plan and scheme of the course.

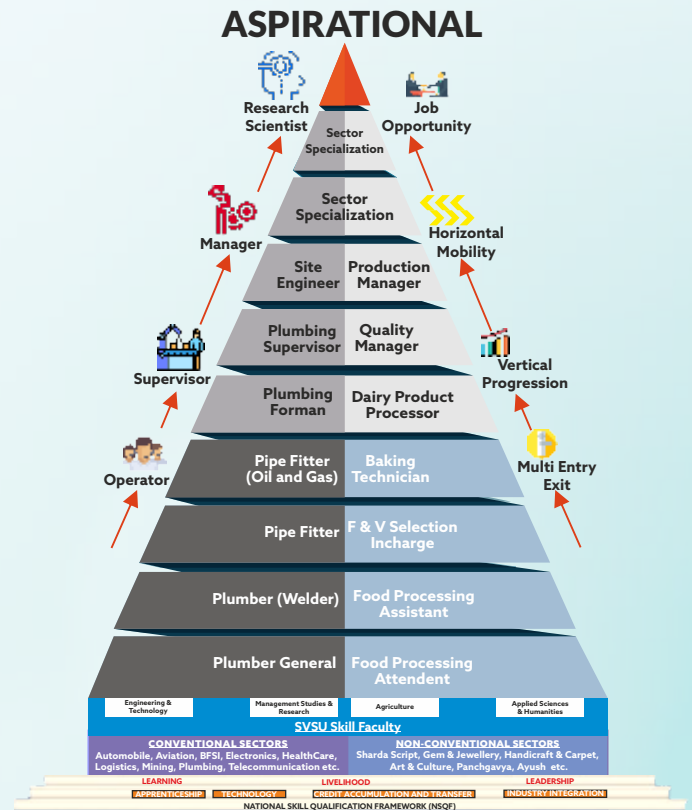
Day 2
