Admission Procedure

Overview

- 1. For Out-Campus programmes: The student must have attained the age of 18 years as on 10-01-2025 for programmes in which OJT will be offered in 2nd Semester on 15-08-2024 where OJT shall be started in 1st Semester (BVoc Mechatronics Hero Motocorp) For D.Voc. programmes, In case of deviation, the decision of CA shall be □nal. Only those students who meets the eligibility of age for admission during OJT will be admitted
- 2. For In-Campus programmes: there is no minimum age of applying for admissions.
- 3. No. of seats may increase or decrease without any personal communication to the candidates.
- 4. In such programmes where the industry partner has yet to be □nalised, detailed information will be released later.
- 5. The stipend will be paid at the discretion of the industry partners and will be paid exclusively during the OJT period. It is not a matter of right.
- 6. If the number of students admitted in a programme is less than 30% of sanctioned intake, programme will not be offered. However 100% fees will be refunded on the request of student or student may be allowed to select other programmes based on his or her eligibility subject to availability of seats, however student will have to comply with the selection procedure.
- 7. The programmes are offered in collaboration and consultation with Industry partners. If proposed industry partner does not accord consent, the programme may not be offered session 2024-25. The Industry partners are tentative and may change.
- 8. This is for applicable cases for relaxation in minimum eligibility marks for reserved category (SC/ST) Candidates. The Chief Secretary to Govt. Haryana, Chandigarh conveyed the instructions vide letter No. 22/129/2013-1GS III dated 16.07.2014 regarding prescribing minimum eligibility quali □cation for the various courses for reserved candidates as per the procedure in compliance with the judgment of Hon ble Supreme Court passed in CWP No. 7084/2011 e.g. "A General candidate requires to have 50% marks, then as per Govt. instructions by giving 5% relaxation the minimum eligibility marks for a reserved caste candidate should be calculated as under:-

Out of 100 marks needs to less = 5

Out of 1 Marks needs to less = 5/100

Out of 50 marks needs to less = $(5/100) \times 50 = 2.50$

This way, minimum fewer marks where general category candidates are required to have 50% in a prescribed quali \Box cation, the total required marks for reserved candidates will be 50-2.50=47.50 and not 45."

Note (Supernumerary Seats)

- 02 seats will be available in each programme with an intake up to 30 for the domicile/ residents of Dudhola village Panchayat (s), who have gifted their land free of cost/on-lease to the state government (As per noti□cation of the State Government).
- 01 seat is reserved for migrants from J&K in each programme.
- 10% seats are offered to women candidate in each programme (Except B.Tech/M.Tech/MBA/MBA Executive/ Lateral Entry) Details mentioned in Annexure A-1.
- 01 seat for the industry sponsored women candidate in each programme (Except B.Tech/M.Tech/MBA/Executive MBA/ M.Phil (CP)/Lateral Entry). Details mentioned in Annexure A-2.

In the event of quota reserved for Physically Handicapped remains unutilized due to non-availability for suitable category of Handicapped Candidates, it may be offered to the Ex- Servicemen and their wards (1%) and the dependents of Freedom Fighters (l%). Further, 3% reservation is also provided to Ex-servicemen/ Freedom Fighters and their dependents by providing reservation within reservation of 1% out of General Category, 1% out of Scheduled Caste and l% from Backward Classed category for admission to the various educational institutions of the Govt. and Govt. aided / Institutes located in Haryana. As far as Block allocation in Block-A and Block-B of Backward Classes category is concerned, year wise rotational system will be adopted. For example, if Block-A of Backward Classes are given seats in academic year 2024, the next Block i.e., (B) Block of Category of Backward Classes will be given seats in the next academic year 2025 and so on. Further, a roster register for reservation of seats for ex-servicemen/freedom

ghters shall be maintained and carry forward all fractions, till one seat is accumulated through different fractions over the years. As and when the total comes to one, a seat will be provided.

Fifty percent of the twenty percent seats reserved for Scheduled Castes for admission in any educational institution shall be provided to candidates belonging to deprived Scheduled Castes as enumerated in the Annexure: B-1.

Where a seat is reserved for candidate from the deprived Scheduled Castes for admission in Government Educational Institution is not \Box lled up in any academic year due to non-availability of candidate of the deprived Scheduled Castes possessing the requisite quali \Box cation, the same shall be made available to the candidate of Schedule Caste.

 The reservation of seats in various programmes is per the reservation policy of the Government of Haryana and is subject to change/amendments made by the Government from time to time.

Guidelines for Admission

- 1. The reservation of seats will be as per the latest Reservation Policy of the State Govt. revised from time to time.
- 2. All the eligible candidates irrespective of their category shall be eligible for AIC seats.
- 3. All eligible candidates deemed to be bona ☐ de residents of Haryana for Admission purpose irrespective of their category shall be eligible ☐ rst for HOGC seats.
- 4. Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from a University/ College/ School situated within the State of Haryana, will be deemed Haryana Residents and will not be required to submit certicate of Bonacde Resident of Haryana notwithstanding the intentions in Annexure B-3 VIII(2)
- 5. The admission process for all Programmes will be held in Physical mode only. No request for attending counselling in online mode shall be entertained.
- 6. The Provisional Merit List will be prepared category wise for all programmes. Accordingly, Seat Allocation list for all admissions will be displayed on the University website. No personal communication shall be carried out.
- 7. The candidate(s) will have to deposit fees through online mode (Debit/ Credit card/ Net banking) only as per the dates mentioned in the counseling schedule. Accordingly, the Provisional Admission Letter shall be issued after the fee deposited by the candidate.
- 8. If a candidate does not deposit the fee, then he/she will not be allowed to participate in the subsequent counseling. However, he/she will be allowed to participate in the subsequent cycles of counseling (if any) and also will be allowed to participate in "On the Spot Admission" counseling (date to be announced later on) on the availability of any vacant seat(s).
- 9. If at any stage, it is found that the candidate has supplied incomplete and/or false and/or incorrect information, his/her candidature for the programme, if admitted, will be cancelled and he/she will be liable for disciplinary action as per the university rules and the fee deposited by him/her shall be forfeited.
- 10. The seats remaining vacant in different categories after each cycle of counseling will be offered to the respective categories in the subsequent counseling. The schedule of the counseling(s), if any, will be announced later on and shall be published on University website.
- 11. If any seat in BC (B) category remains vacant, the same will be □lled up from BC (A) category and vice-versa after second counselling or after the candidate of a particular category is exhausted.

- 12. If any seat in SC category remains vacant, the same will be □lled up from SC(D) and vice-versa after second counselling or after the candidates of a particular category is exhausted.
- 13. The seats reserved for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) candidates, if remaining vacant after the Physical counselling(s) will be □rst offered to the candidates of the EWS at the start of the physical counselling as per schedule noti □ed, after being offered to the candidates of EWS if seats still remain un □lled after cutoff time as per schedule, the same will be converted into General Category of Haryana as the case may be.
- 14. Bene to f reservation will be given to all the reserved categories upto 3rd Merit List. In case reserved seats other than SC seats are vacant even after 3rd Merit List, then these vacant seats will be thrown open to Haryana General Category. In case, the seats in Haryana General Category remain vacant at the end the same will be thrown to All India Open Category.
- 15. Seats belonging to any reserved category will be converted to unreserved category as decided by the university in accordance with the rules of Government of Haryana. However, candidates belonging to respective reserved category ful ☐ lling other eligibility conditions will also be considered on priority basis within the limits of time as decided by the University. In the event of seats remaining vacant/un ☐ lled, if any, the same shall be ☐ lled up before ☐ nal cut-off date of admissions without any reservation.
- 16. Further, the Vice- Chancellor is authorized to add any instructions related to counselling for all the programmes.

Instructions for Personal Interview/ Aptitude Test/ Professional Test/ Group Discussion

Personal Interview/Aptitude Test/Professional Test/Group Discussion is an essential component for admission to various programmes for which a list of short-listed candidates shall be prepared keeping in view the reservation policy and number of seats in each category. This list of short-listed candidates shall be displayed on the Notice Board of the University and also on the website. No separate communication will be sent to the candidate. Information regarding location and time of Personal Interview/Aptitude Test/Professional Test/Group Discussion of the short-listed candidates will be available on University website.

Candidates must bring the relevant original documents and two sets of self-attested photocopies of documents/certi cates/testimonials for veri cation at the time of Personal Interview/Aptitude Test/ Professional Test/Group Discussion.

Note:

- Candidates must qualify in personal interview, aptitude test, professional test, group discussion, and other tests independently, if applicable, in order to be considered for the programme. Merely, Clearing the test or Personal Interview, the student cannot claim for admission, the right to admission is reserved to the University.
- 2. Candidates in multiples of seven times the sanctioned intake will be contacted for personal interviews/group discussion in the □rst round, based on the merit of the qualifying examination (step.1).
- 3. Regardless of merit prepared based on the qualifying examination, candidates who were rejected in personal interviews/group discussions will not be considered for the next stage of the selection process (Step no.1).

Guidelines for Registration and Fees Submission

- 1. University issues the notice of registration and fee deposition in every semester as per academic calendar.
- 2. The students are required to deposit their Registration form with applicable fee as per the schedule without late fee.
- 3. After that, the students are allowed to submit their Registration form with applicable semester fee with a □ne of Rs.10 per day as per the schedule noti□ed by the University.
- 4. University notify the list of registered students who are allowed to attend the classes/OJT
- 5. Last opportunity is provided to students for re-admission for another 10 days subject to the ful lment of conditions as per university norms. The Un-registered students may apply for Re-registration/Re-admission with recommendation of Program coordinator and respective Dean/Chairperson with semester fees, a Re- admission fee of Rs.1000/- and a lne of Rs.10 per day by taking into consideration of 75% attendance for Theory and 90% for OJT in the semester from the date of readmission which is mandatory condition for all the students.
- 6. The students may attend the classes/OJT from the date of registration/Re-admission.
- 7. Students who failed to submit the fees as above, their names will be struck off from the University records and will not be allowed to attend the classes.

General Instructions For Online Application Form

- Before □lling the Online Application Form, candidates are required to read the Prospectus/ Guidelines/Instructions available on University website carefully. Candidates will submit their Application Forms online on the University's website: www.svsu.ac.in for admission to various programmes.
- 2. No column should be left blank in the Online Application Form; write N.A. against the column which is not applicable. Otherwise, it will be considered as incomplete and is liable to be rejected.
- 3. In case any candidate is found to have supplied false information, certi □ cates, documents, etc. or withheld or concealed some information in his/her Application Form, he/she shall be liable to be debarred from admission to the programme.
- 4. As per directions of Director, Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula, vide their letter no. 18/30-2015 UNP (4) dated 08.03.2017, linking of AADHAR ID with bank account is mandatory for all students to be admitted in the University Teaching Departments/Faculties and af □liated Colleges/Faculties w.e.f. the session 2017-18. Every student must be in possession of AADHAR number at the time of admission.

General Instructions for counselling

- 1. The merit list based on the selection criterion and reservation policy of Government of Haryana shall be published on the University website.
- 2. The admission-counselling schedule will be published on University website. University will not make any personal communication.
- 3. All the applicants mandatorily attend the admission counselling as per the noti □ed date and time and location. No request of online attending of the admission counselling shall be entertained.
- 4. Requisite fees as per the programme will be accepted through Debit card/Credit card/Bank Draft and will not be accepted in cash.

Under no circumstances original certi □ cate shall be taken from the candidates.

- 9. Candidates seeking admission for Haryana seats are required to submit a certi□cate of bona□de resident of Haryana as de□ned by the Haryana Govt if they have not passed their Qualifying exam from a Board/ University of Haryana. The Certi□cate of Haryana Resident shall be in the formats prescribed by the Govt. and issued by the competent authority.
- 10. A complete merit list of all eligible candidates will be prepared for each category.
- 11. Candidates having passed qualifying examination from self- styled Universities/Institutes/Boards declared bogus/fake by UGC and other govt. bodies shall not be eligible for admission to any programme in Shri Vishwakarma Skill University. This list may vary from time to time as per Noti □ cation of UGC/ other govt. bodies.

Rules of Refund of Fees after Cancellation of Admission

Rules of Refund of Fees after Cancellation of Admission

The University strictly follows UGC/AICTE guidelines for refund of fees published time to time. In case of the cancellation of admission. The following clause of UGC, vide Notification dated October, 2018, for 'Remittance and Refund of Fees' will be followed: -

4.1.3. If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he/she is enrolled, the institution concerned shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees** remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of fees**	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in Higher Educational Institutions (HEI)
1	100%	15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission
2	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission
3	80%	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission
4	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of Admission
5	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission

**NOTE:

4.1.4 In case of (i) in the table above, the Higher Educational Institution (HEI) concerned shall deduct an amount not more than 5% of the fees paid by the student/s, subject to a maximum of Rs. 5000/- as processing charges from the refundable amount.

For B.Tech programmes, guidelines of refund of fees shall be followed as issued by HSTES/AICTE.
